Directions to Manchester Community College
1066 Front Street, Manchester, NH

The campus is located at 1066 Front Street, Rt 3A, which is 200 yards from Exit 7, Interstate 293 North (Route 3). Or take Exit 10 from Interstate 93 North or South. At the end of the exit ramp, take a left at the STOP sign and continue for approximately 2 miles.

The college driveway is on the right. Be prepared to take a sharp right turn.

505 Amherst St, Nashua, NH

The campus is located at 505 Amherst Street. Take Everett Turnpike/Rt. 3 to exit 8 (Milford), at "T" intersection (approx 1.5 miles) make a right onto Amherst St/Rt. 101A. Go to 3rd traffic light (approx 0.8mile) and make a right onto Thornton Rd. College is on left.
